

Aggieland Homeschool Athletics (AHA) Policy on the Prevention and Mitigation of Abuse, Molestation or Sexual Misconduct

Scope: The following identifies the Aggieland Homeschool Athletics (AHA) policy on the prevention and mitigation of abuse, molestation or sexual misconduct.

Purpose: To protect all AHA student athletes (minors) from abuse, molestation or sexual misconduct when engaged in any AHA sports program events to include competitions, practices and anytime a student athlete is under the care of an AHA sanctioned volunteer coach, assistant coach, or any other AHA sports program approved volunteer that is responsible for supervision of student athletes during competition, practices or during transportation to/from such events.

Procedures: The following procedures will be followed to protect our student athletes.

1. All known or suspected abuse incidents must be reported to law enforcement.
2. Each AHA Sports Program volunteer coach, assistant coach and anyone else who has been sanctioned by the sports program to supervise student athletes must be provided a written copy of this policy.
3. The three person rule* will be adhered to when student athletes are under the supervision of volunteer coaches, assistant coaches or anyone else who has been sanctioned by the Sports Program to supervise student athletes.
*The three-person rule prohibits one adult from being alone with one youth. A second adult must be present, or there must be two or more youths with an adult.

As a coach or leader supervising student athletes in an AHA sport, I acknowledge I have read this policy and agree to follow the procedures.
